exhibits showcasing rare species such as; Clouded Leopards, Siamese Crocodiles, Pythons, Blackbuck, and exotic birds. White Rhinoceroses and Maasai Giraffes

can be seen roaming the lushly landscaped **African**

habitat. See the only **Hippoquarium** exhibit in the south central United States featuring Nile

Hippopotamus.

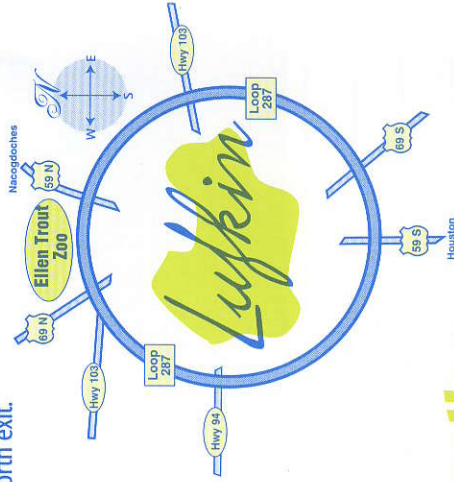
When & Where
